500-750 Words—Typed, double spaced, on an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ X 11 paper.

September 11th Firefighter Henry Miller Jr. Memorial High School Scholarship

Write about an inspirational character that you have read about. Use examples as evidence to show how that character has influenced your life.

750-1000 Words—Typed, double spaced, on an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ X 11 paper.

Application Guidelines and Rules

- All applicants must attend a District 26 Public School. High School students from Benjamin Cardozo, Francis Lewis, Bayside, Queens High School of Teaching, Martin Van Buren and Business Technology Early College are eligible for the high school scholarship.
- All entries must meet grade level writing standards.
- All students must have satisfactory behavior.
- All students should be active in their school/community, and/or involved in extra-curricular activities.
- Students should have no more than 10 latenesses and/or absences for the current school year.
- Students may only submit one application.
- All students should be aware that classroom teachers will be contacted regarding attendance, and behavior.
- Each student submission must have student's name, school and contact information and parent/guardian's permission slip attached.
- The student must be present on Thursday, March 31, 2016 at the scholarship dinner dance to be presented with a check and certificate.
- The committee can select Honorable Mention Awardees—those students will receive a certificate.
- Entries from Third grade through high school will not be considered if they do not meet the minimum/maximum word requirements.
- Only mailed applications will be considered.
